¡Viva Jesús!

Dear Knights of Columbus Family,

On Sunday March 31, 2022 we celebrated Easter Sunday, the day that Jesus Christ rose from the dead. Jesus' resurrection, raises an important reflection question for each one of us. Do I truly believe, in my heart, that Jesus rose from the dead? The resurrection is a critical, because if Jesus didn't rise from the dead, then Christianity is a scam. And Jesus would be no different than any other first century Palestinian itinerant preacher walking around claiming to be the Messiah, the Son of God. All of Christianity hinges on Jesus' resurrection, and distinguishes Christianity from all other religions.

There are many non-Christian historical documents that support the gospel's account of Jesus' crucifixion, his crucifixion cannot be denied. His resurrection, however, not as easy to prove. The question is, are the gospel accounts of the empty tomb on Easter morning true historical events.

There are three options that could have happened on Easter morning:

1) His disciples dug a tunnel from Jerusalem to somewhere far away, without anyone seeing them digging in the desert. When Jesus was placed in the tomb, he walked out after being crucified. Highly unlikely, in fact impossible. How would the disciples know the exact spot where Jesus would be crucified?

2) The disciples were able to sneak into a tomb that was covered by a stone that was 4-6 feet in diameter and possibly 2,000-4,000 pounds, and guarded with strict instructions by the Roman military. The Roman military, would have been seen as powerful as the United States Military today. Jesus' disciples would have snuck in the tomb without the Roman soldiers seeing them, and taking Jesus' dead body.

3) Jesus, the Son of God, rose from the dead, and transcended from the tomb.

Another helpful reflection point, What transformed the Apostles, from 11 men who were filled with absolute fear, to the courageous men who were willing to die for Jesus? A review of the Acts of the Apostles, will point you to the resurrected Jesus!!!

Querida familia de los Caballeros de Colón, El domingo 31 de marzo de 2022 celebramos el domingo de Pascua, el día en que Jesucristo resucitó de entre los muertos. La resurrección de Jesús plantea una importante cuestión de reflexión para cada uno de nosotros. ¿De verdad creo, en mi corazón, que Jesús resucitó de entre los muertos? La resurrección es crítica, porque si Jesús no resucitó de entre los muertos, entonces el cristianismo es una estafa. Y Jesús no sería diferente a cualquier otro predicador itinerante palestino del primer siglo que caminaba por ahí afirmando ser el Mesías, el Hijo de Dios. Todo el cristianismo depende de la resurrección de Jesús y distingue al cristianismo de todas las demás religiones. Hay muchos documentos históricos no cristianos que apoyan el relato del evangelio de la crucifixión de Jesús, su crucifixión no se puede negar. Su resurrección, sin embargo, no es tan fácil de probar. La pregunta es, ¿son los verdaderos acontecimientos históricos de los relatos del evangelio de la tumba vacía en la mañana de Pascua?

Hay tres opciones que podrían haber ocurrido en la mañana de Pascua:

1) Sus discípulos cavaron un túnel desde Jerusalén hasta algún lugar lejano, sin que nadie los viera cavar en el desierto. Cuando Jesús fue colocado en la tumba, salió después de ser crucificado. Muy poco probable, de hecho imposible. ¿Cómo sabrían los discípulos el lugar exacto donde Jesús sería crucificado?

2) Los discípulos pudieron colarse en una tumba que estaba cubierta por una piedra de 4-6 pies de diámetro y posiblemente de 2.000 a 4.000 libras, y custodiada con estrictas instrucciones por parte del ejército romano. El ejército romano habría sido visto tan poderoso como el ejército de los Estados Unidos hoy en día. Los discípulos de Jesús se habrían colado en la tumba sin que los soldados romanos los vieran y se llevaran el cadáver de Jesús.

3) Jesús, el Hijo de Dios, resucitó de entre los muertos y trascendió de la tumba. Otro punto de reflexión útil, ¿qué transformó a los Apóstoles, de 11 hombres que estaban llenos de miedo absoluto, a los hombres valientes que estaban dispuestos a morir por Jesús? ¡Una revisión de los Hechos de los Apóstoles le señalará al Jesús resucitado!
